

Hilda's Caramel Dessert

(from Hilda Pearson's demonstration)

Place Unopened can of Eagle Brand Sweetened Condensed Milk in a deep pan. Cover with water One inch above the Condensed Milk can. Bring the water to a boil-then turn down and simmer for 3 hours.

Remove from water. Do Not Open Can. Cool to room temperature and then refrigerate. Open when ready to serve, this stays good forever until it is opened.

Place caramel in a fancy bowl or sherbet dish, top with Pineapple & Whipped cream.
