Dear Mr. Conradt;

An antenna tower is proposed to be constructed approximately 2.4 miles south southwest (see enclosed Google Earth screen shot) of the Wayne Municipal Airport. This tower will be 248' tall with a final height of 1852' AMSL. This tower is within the airport Turning Zone and violates the height restriction of the Turning Zone by 98',

The FAA has issued a determination of "Determination of No Hazard to Air Navigation." Included in the determination is a requirement for marking and lighting. Copies of these documents are enclosed.

**** DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD TO AIR NAVIGATION ****

The Federal Aviation Administration has conducted an aeronautical study under the provisions of 49 U.S.C., Section 44718 and if applicable Title 14 of the Code of Federal Regulations, part 77, concerning:

Structure:	Tower Wayne Tower
Location:	Wayne, NE

Heights:	1604 feet site elevation (SE) 248 feet above ground level (AGL) 1852 feet above mean sea level (AMSL)

This aeronautical study revealed that the structure does exceed obstruction standards but would not be a hazard to air navigation provided the following condition(s), if any, is(are) met:

As a condition to this Determination, the structure should continue to be marked/lighted utilizing paint/red lights.

Any failure or malfunction that lasts more than thirty (30) minutes and affects a top light or flashing obstruction light, regardless of its position, should be reported immediately to (877) 487-6867 so a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) can be issued. As soon as the normal operation is restored, notify the same number.

See attachment for additional condition(s) or information.

This determination is based, in part, on the foregoing description which includes specific coordinates, heights, frequency(ies) and power. Any changes in coordinates, heights, and frequencies or use of greater power will void this determination. Any future construction or alteration, including increase to heights, power, or the addition of other transmitters, requires separate notice to the FAA.

This determination does include temporary construction equipment such as cranes, derricks, etc., which may be used during actual construction of the structure. However, this equipment shall not exceed the overall heights as indicated above. Equipment which has a height greater than the studied structure requires separate notice to the FAA.

This determination concerns the effect of this structure on the safe and efficient use of navigable airspace by aircraft and does not relieve the sponsor of compliance responsibilities relating to any law, ordinance, or regulation of any Federal, State, or local government body.

This aeronautical study included evaluation of a structure that exists at this time. Action will be taken to ensure aeronautical charts are updated to reflect the most current coordinates, elevation and height as indicated in the case description.

A copy of this determination will be forwarded to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) because the structure is subject to their licensing authority.

This determination cancels and supersedes prior determinations issued for this structure.


The existing structure is located approximately 2.44 NM south of the Airport Reference Point for Wayne Municipal Stan Morris Field (LCG), Wayne, NE. It is identified as exceeding Title 4 CFR, Part 77 Obstruction Standards as follows as applied to LCG:


Section 77.17(a)(2): A height that is 200 feet AGL, or above the established airport elevation, whichever is higher, within 3 nautical miles of the established reference point of an airport, excluding heliports, with its longest runway more than 3,200 feet in actual length, and that height increases in the proportion of 100 feet for each additional nautical mile from the airport up to a maximum of 499 feet. It exceeds by 48 feet.


The FAA will continue to accommodate the existing structure at the current AGL height.
