

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-1

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A NON-EXCLUSIVE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH ALLO ASSET ENTITY 1, LLC, A NEBRASKA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY (“ALLO”), ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAYNE, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. ALLO is transitioning away from their traditional cable television product due to increasing costs of content and technology becoming uncompetitive for their customers; and

Section 2. This transition is requiring them to enter into an agreement (attached) to replace their existing Cable Franchise Ordinance No. 2020-20, dated November 17, 2020, which currently governs their federally-regulated Cable Service operations in Wayne and provides ALLO the authority to occupy public rights-of-way.

Section 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect as of March 31, 2026.
