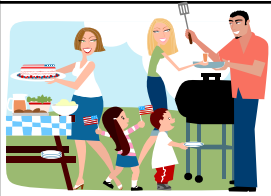

Ole wore both of his winter jackets when he painted his house last July. The directions on the can said "put on two coats".

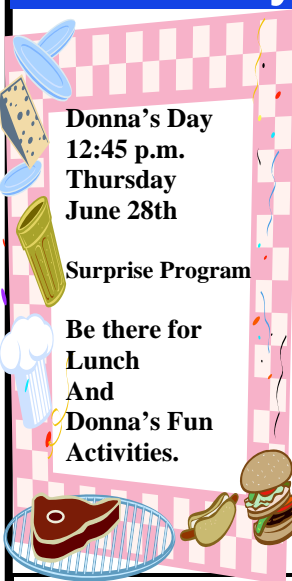

Angel Fluff

15 to 20 marshmallows

1 dozen Graham Crackers

1 cup milk

1 small can drained pineapple

3/4 container of frozen whipped topping

1/2 chopped nuts

Melt marshmallows in milk, stirring frequently.

Cool. When cool add pineapple and chopped nuts.

Fold in whipped topping. Crush 1 dozen graham
crackers and spread into a 9 inch square pan.

Pour mixture over the crackers, evenly. Sprinkle with
Graham Crackers. Chill for two hours.
